KLCS FAILED TO AIR THE REQUIRED MINIMUM 120 SECONDS OF DTV CONSUMER EDUCATION ANNOUNCEMENTS ON A SINGLE DAY, JULY 1, 2008 (ON THAT DATE, TWO 30 SECOND SPOTS WERE AIRED IN THE 6 P.M. TO MIDNIGHT TIME SLOT); THIS DEFICIENCY WAS REPORTED TO THE FCC IN A SEPTEMBER 24, 2008 RESPONSE TO AN ENFORCEMENT BUREAU INQUIRY (FILE NO. EB-08-SE-771). AS SET FORTH IN THAT SEPTEMBER 24 RESPONSE, SAFEGUARDS WERE IMMEDIATELY PUT IN PLACE TO INSURE FULL COMPLIANCE AND, IN FACT, DURING THE THIRD QUARTER, KLCS AIRED A TOTAL OF 375.5 MINUTES OF DTV CONSUMER EDUCATION SPOTS DURING 6 P.M.
